In a group, you will be using your knowledge and expertise with LightWave, sketching, writing and storyboards to produce a movie. One of the best ways to produce this movie is to divide the sections of the movie up amongst the group members. Each group member should work on areas of their strengths. For example, if someone in your group is an expert at modeling, they should direct the modeling of the characters. Remember, all group members will be graded on the outcome of the movie.

The movie will have a rendered playing time of between three to five minutes. You may add sound (music or effects) if you wish. Each group member will be graded on the following:

_____ **Movie Idea (100 points):** Fully complete the Movie Idea sheet. You will be graded on your answers, so answer in detail. One Movie Idea sheet will be turned in for each group.

_____ **Story/Screenwriting (100 points):** Describe in detail what will happen in each segment of the movie. The story must have a beginning, climatic point and ending. Include the character names and what they will be doing.

_____ **Character Sketches/Development (100 points):** The movie will have a minimum of four characters. On the Sketch sheet, draw in detail the look of each character. Include a front and side view of each.

_____ **Storyboard (100 points):** Draw each major movement or segment of your movie in a separate frame of a storyboard. You will use a minimum of ten frames.

Character Modeling (100 points per character): Each character should be fully modeled.

_____ **Scene and Props (100 points):** The movie's backgrounds and props should be developed and modeled to work with the characters.
