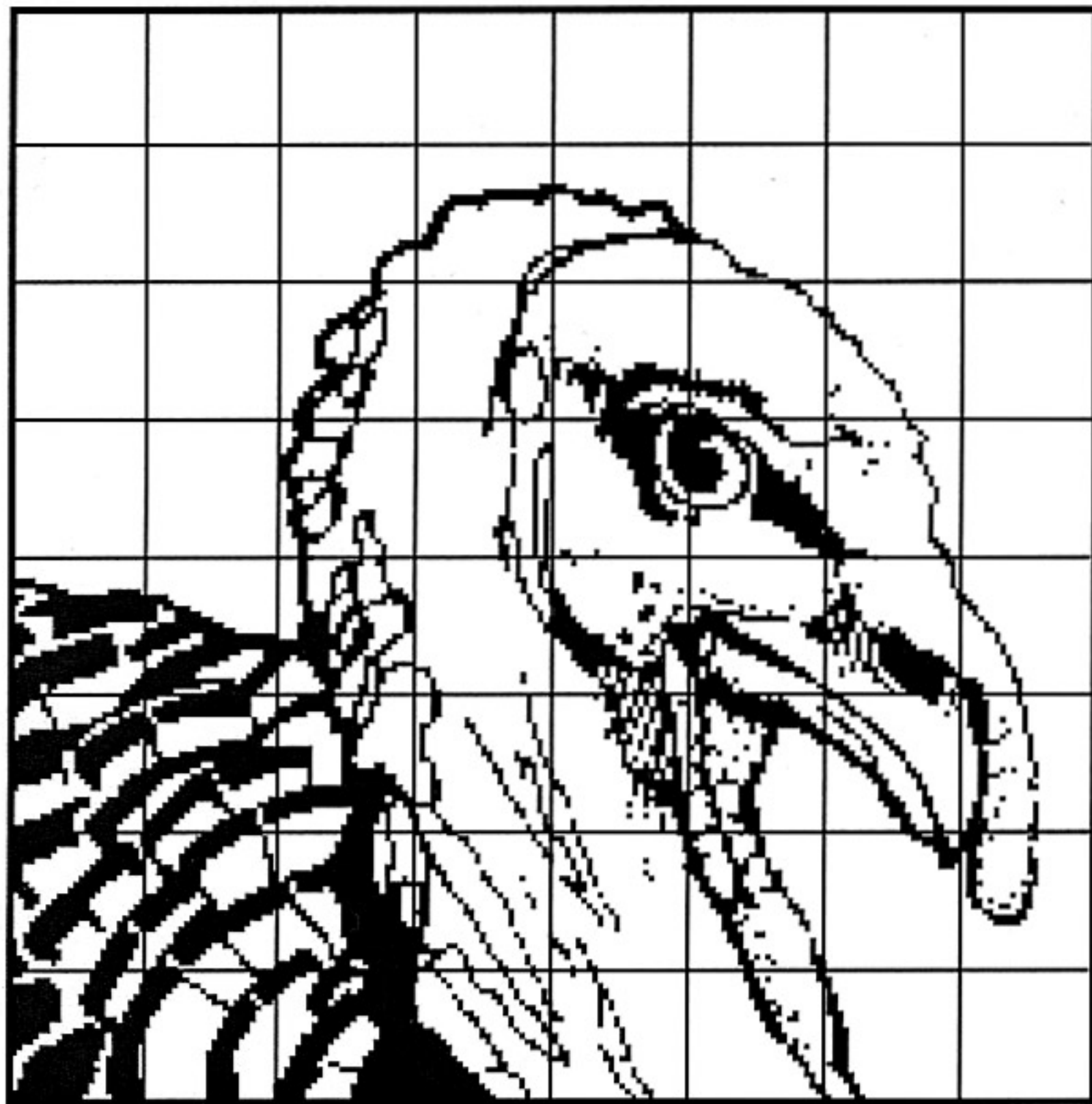


Practice grid drawing in PhotoShop



This is an exercise to help you control the mouse in PhotoShop and also proportionately enlarge an image. Follow the directions closely and don't get frustrated. You don't need to save this to your zip disk.

1. Open a new page in PhotoShop (File>New) that measures 8" x 8".
2. Select View>Show Ruler.
3. Deselect "Snap" by clicking View> Snap.
4. Click on a ruler and drag a guide bar out to the one inch mark (remember, guide bars don't print).
5. Continue to drag guide bars out from both the top and bottom rulers to each inch mark until you've made a grid.
6. Select the pencil tool (hold down the paintbrush tool) and set the brush size to 5.
7. Redraw the turkey box by box on the PhotoShop page. Think of each box on the copy of the turkey as a small picture. The copy of the turkey is bitmapped (jagged edges), but your drawing can be smooth. Color your drawing if you have time.
8. Print on the black and white printer.
