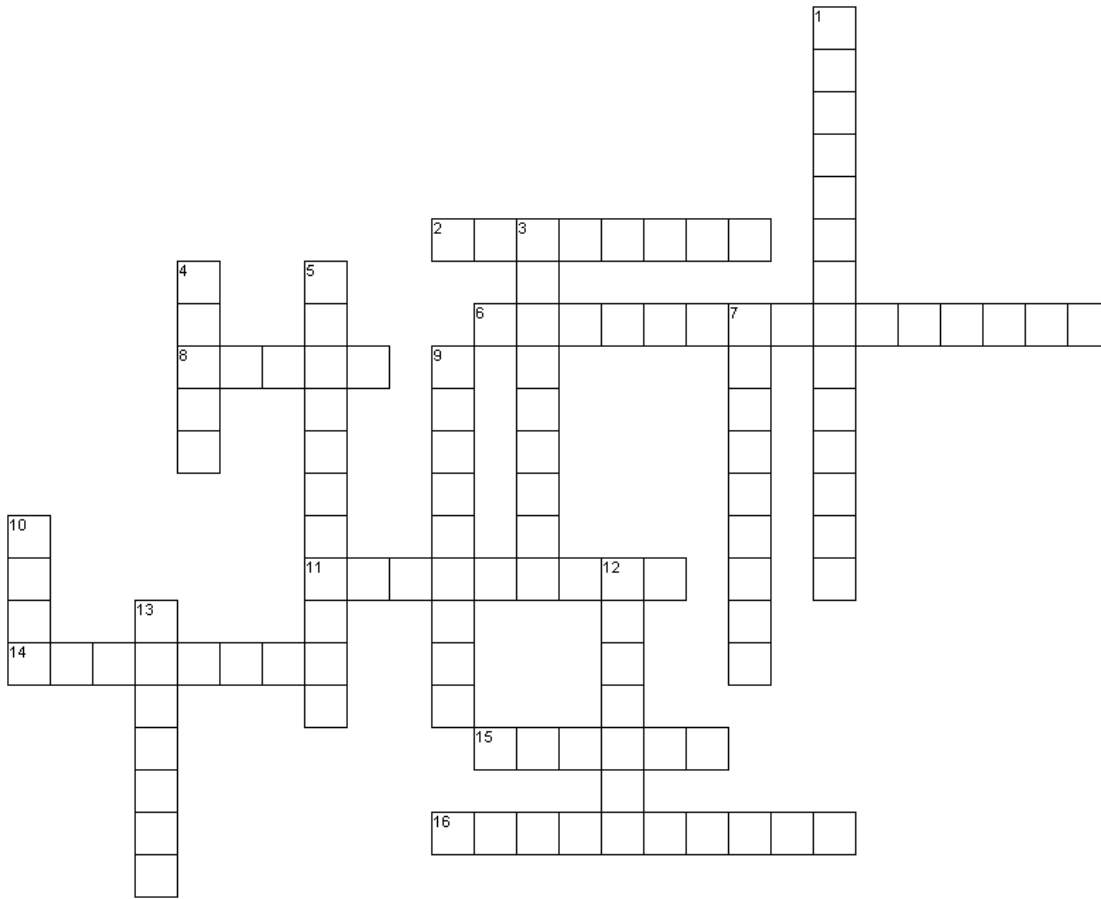


Working With Type

8. A serif face font. The most commonly used typeface classification. The most legible.
11. Another name for Type Family Members. Includes bold, italic, and condensed.
14. May be an interchangeable term with font.
15. A classification of type based on hand-writing. Individual letters may be connected.
16. The design and use of typefaces as a means of visual communication.

1. Left side of text block is aligned (there is a hyphen in the term).
3. Lining up the top, bottom, sides, or middle of type.
4. The little strokes found at the end of main vertical and horizontal strokes of some typefaces.
5. A type classification based on early calligraphy that features elaborate thick to thin strokes and serifs.
7. Both sides of a block of text are aligned.
9. A type classification without serifs (term is two words – do not include space between words).
10. Refers to a typeface.
12. The space between lines of type.
13. The adjustment of space between letters.
