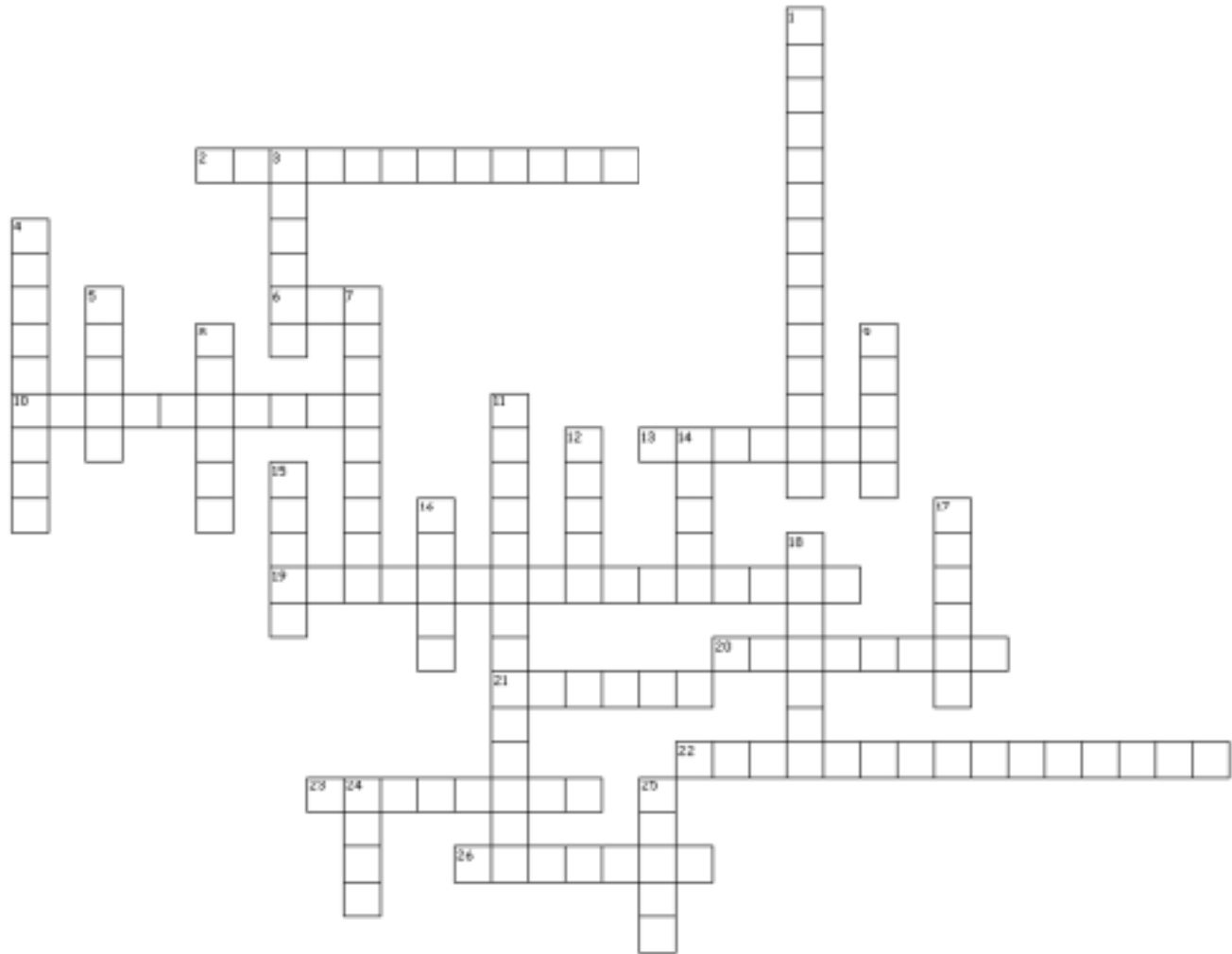


History of Computers Crossword Puzzle

2. He is credited for building the first digital computer (Arithmetic Machine) in 1642.
6. The Computing-Tabulating Recording Company formed by Herman Hollerith in 1896 (later known as International Business Machines).
10. This device, invented in 1947, had the same capabilities as a vacuum tube but broke less often and used less power.
13. Microsoft formally launches this NT 3.1 version in 1993.
19. Microsoft releases this web browser in 1996 with its 3.0 version.
20. This world-wide web browser is released in 1994 by Mosaic Communications.
21. A wooden rack with wires and beads capable of solving regular arithmetic problems. This device was invented over 2000 years ago (about 500 b.c.).
22. In 1890, he developed a device for the U.S. Census Bureau that could read information on punch cards.
23. Software Arts releases this program which is the first spreadsheet and business program in 1979.
26. This type of computer was first introduced by IBM in 1981. It becomes the standard for business PCs.

1. Intel first invented this in 1970. It was known as the Intel 4004.
3. In 1974, this first microcomputer (PC) was invented.
4. This Apple computer was first introduced in 1984. It featured a simple, graphical user interface (somewhat like a windows desktop).
5. A high-speed electronic computer developed for the needs of World War II in 1943. It used 18,000 vacuum tubes and was the first electronic general purpose computer.
7. In 1975, Bill Gates and Paul Allen drop out of Harvard to form this company.
8. The first commercially available computer. Invented in 1948.
9. In 1963, this pointing device was invented.
11. From about 1812-1840, this person used the predictability of numbers to invent the Analytical Engine.
12. Steve Jobs and Steve Wozniak found this company in 1976.
14. Founded in 1968 by Robert Noyce and Gordon Moore.
15. A programming language invented in 1964.
16. The ISO 9660:88 was adopted for this format in 1988.
17. A storage disk first invented in 1967.
18. Intel introduces this processor in 1993.
24. This Apple computer is released in 1998.
25. The first IBM _____ PC was released in 1982 by Columbus Data Products.
