

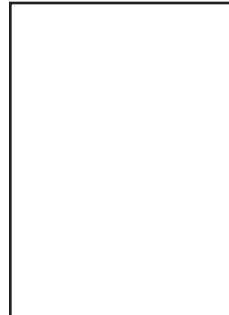
Digital Landscape Painting - Corel Painter

Size:

10" x 8"

or

8" x 10"



Program: Corel Painter

Requirements:

1. Find a photograph of a landscape from a magazine, Internet, or from a photograph that you have taken. Try to avoid photographs that contain buildings, people, or are extremely detailed.
2. With a pencil, sketch the landscape on a standard sheet of paper. The sketch should only be a line drawing, so shading is not necessary.
3. In Corel Painter, go to File > New and open a new canvas. Set the size of the page to be 8 X 10 inches. Change the resolution to 150 pixels per inch.
4. Using a small sized brush, redraw your pencil sketch on the canvas in Painter.
5. Choose the colors and the media (i.e. oil paints, watercolors, or a mixture) and begin painting your painting. Remember to start with the areas farthest back and work forward (for example, start with the sky, then work on the mountains, and then the foreground objects).
6. Save your painting as a jpeg file on your flash drive.
7. Print your painting in color.
