Go back in time at least 10 years. Remember being entertained by those simple – usually strange – nursery rhymes? It's time to relive those days! Your assignment is to make a LightWave version of a nursery rhyme. You say you can't remember any? Lucky you! They can all be found on the Internet.

1. Do an Internet search for nursery rhymes. One good site is www.zelo.com/family/nursery.
2. Choose a nursery rhyme that can be translated into a picture.
3. Make a pencil sketch of the rhyme you chose. You don't have to spend a lot of time on the sketch.
4. Create all objects needed for your rhyme picture in Modeler.
5. Open the objects in Layout and create the nursery rhyme scene. Include textures, backgrounds, etc.
6. Save to both your CD and student folder. Render and print your nursery rhyme scene.

You will be graded on the following:

- Pencil Sketch (50 Points)
- Nursery Rhyme Scene (100 Points)

Extra Credit (15 Points): If you feel ambitious – and have the time – make a story board and animate your scene in a SIMPLE animation.
